Everything you Need for a Jesse Tree Advent

An Advent Wreath -

- Greenery and candle holders arranged in a circle around a white pillar candle
- 3 purple taper candles
- 1 pink taper candle
- matches

Every Sunday we light the candles, read the story, sing hymns, and pray together. We relate each story back to the theme of the Sunday (Hope, Faith, Joy, and Love)

A Jesse Tree -

Jesse Tree stories are read every night from December 1 – 25th and a new ornament added to the tree. We briefly summarize every story we've told each night, tracing the thread of Jesus all through the Old Testament.

- A tree, made of paper, felt, cloth, or an actual tree (we hang our ornaments directly on our Advent wreath)

- A set of Jesse Tree ornaments: there are tons of ornaments available to print, make, or buy! We have used and loved the set from Keeping Life Creative.com (search Jesse Tree and Jesse Tree Add Ons)

*The stories in this schedule are from *The Jesus Storybook Bible* by Sally Lloyd Jones. The stories of Ruth, Elijah, and Elizabeth and Zachariah are not found in the storybook Bible, so we read them directly from the Bible, or (when the children were younger) summarize them.

*I glued the Ten Commandments, Red Sea, and Burning Bush together to create the "Moses" Ornament.
